

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
October 10, 2013 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 10, 2013 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Paul Schlemmer. Solicitor, Coty Brandon, Secretary/Treasurer, Janice Marshall and seven visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- road crew doing good job considering township funds; Guy Geissler-Pine Lake Road logging truck damaging road and brush/tree limbs need cut; Dave Windhorst-status of repair/replacement of Barkley Bridge; Jane Windhorst-brush cutting is good.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the September 12, 2013 regular meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to accept the treasurers report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Tax Collection, Roadmaster, Perry Township Municipal Authority, and Permit reports were presented.

Schlemmer motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 10-10-13 approval of the addition of Norma Boots, Timothy Boots and Delvy McElwain properties into the Perry Township Agricultural Security Area. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was noted that the township would be receiving Liquid Fuels Funds in the amount of \$78,164.90 in March.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the advertisement for an outside auditor for the 2013 Year Financial Audit. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to set and advertise the budget workshop dates of October 30 and November 6 at 5:00 p.m. to be held at the municipal building. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to pass the Armstrong Cable/Utility Ordinance #10-10-13 and to sign the ten year Armstrong Agreement between Armstrong Utilities and Perry Township for Cable Service. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Solicitor send a letter to Charles Kriebel concerning the condition of his property at 717 Portersville Road, Ellwood City and his non-compliance with the township nuisance and lot-weed control ordinances.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the hiring of Beth Grossman to clean prior to the township meetings at \$50.00 per month. Motion passed with all in favor.

It was decided not to pursue implementation of a physician panel. A letter from ARMS was discussed and determined not to be interested in their proposal for assistance with the health care laws. There is a need for a constable for the Election Day only.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase the Lawrence County Plat Book and a set of Wall Maps from the county Planning department. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Schlemmer second to purchase the reflective blue address sign blanks and numbers for the 911 addressing needs. Motion passed with all in favor.

The tentative date for the County Township Assoc. meeting is November 13. Items discussed were: ProGas account, HOP procedures, JB Mill damages to Stickle Road, and finalizing of building permits.

Boots motioned to adjourn and Zias second with all in favor.
