

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
October 11, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 11, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich, and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and two visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- equipment, roads and bridges; Michelle Pekich-the expense and extreme problems with her applications for stormwater management and construction of a storage unit building; A lengthy discussion was held about the process of stormwater applications and building permit process.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the minutes of the September 13, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report, tax collection, and permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise for the appointment of an outside audit firm for the 2018 financial audit, to authorize the signing of the contract with Herrman and Loll and to submit it as soon as possible to get the audit completed early in 2019. Motion passed all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to set the budget workshop date as October 22 at 4:00 p.m. and to have it advertised. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to renew the UPMC health insurance for 2019 after the review of the premium rates. Glenn Czerpak, Larry Houk and Doug Duncan are to be covered with Duncan to reimburse the township for his premium. Motion passed with all in favor.

The annual trick or treat night is October 31, from 6-8:00 p.m.

Boots motioned and Zias second to renew the township insurance policies through Kilmer Insurance Group, EMC Insurance, SWIF, Guardian and UPMC. Motion passed with all in favor.

Marshall is to contact PennDot about the intersection of Route 488 at Pleasant Hill Road for safety signs for traffic.

It was decided not to donate to the County Tourism Agency, United Way or place an ad on a local placemat.

Boots motioned and Zias second to sign the documents for the lot located between the Wurtemberg Perry Township Volunteer Fire Department lots which would transfer it to the fire department. The said lot is listed incorrectly as belonging to the township. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Radich second to adjourn. Motion passed.
