

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
November 11, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 11, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radish and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall was in attendance. Three visitors were present. Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order. Those in attendance participated in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitors Comments: As a Representative of the Perry Township Municipal Authority, Tom Hines stated that the Municipal Authority was requesting that Lynn LeViere be reappointed for the five year position on the Municipal Authority Board

Boots motioned and Zias second to appoint Lynn LeViere as the five year Municipal Authority Board Member. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to donate \$13,000 to the Perry Township Municipal Authority for the Sewage repair project at the Sewer Station with the fund being taken out of the American Rescue Fund Account. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the October 14, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. It was noted that a budget workshop was held on October 25th at 4 p.m. at the township building with all three Supervisors and the Secretary present.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster report and permits and tax collection report were handed out.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the 2022 proposed budget and to advertise it for adoption at the December 9, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 11-11-21, Appointment of an outside audit firm, Herrmann and Loll for the 2021 financial audit. Motion passed.

The problem with AT&T cellular phone bill and the hot spot for the fire department was discussed. Marshall is getting information in changing over to First Net for the township and fire department hot spot use in the department's engine.

Boots motioned and Radich second to make a donation of \$5,000.00 to the Mountville Presbyterian Church out of the American Rescue Fund for the non-profit church to help with the loss of funds due to COVID-19 causing lack of membership and income. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the purchase of a new office chair from Staples due to the malfunction of the former one. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Perry Township Office and Tax Collection Office will be closed from November 22 through December 3. Residents are also reminded that tax payments must be made by December 31st or they will be filed as delinquent. No personal or business checks will be accepted after December 15.

Taxpayers are also reminded that it is important to get the taxes paid on time, or there will be larger delinquent fees following the school district changing the collection agency.

Radich motioned and Boots second to make the change in the Website to accommodate a better access for residents. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
