

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
November 14, 2019 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 14, 2019 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radich, and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- McCartney Hollow road widening project – electric pole not moved yet; John Cernus-his vehicles in Perry Township are in compliance, have inspections and registrations required, the majority of the vehicles are in Franklin Township.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the October 10, 2019 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. It was reported that a budget workshop was held at 4 p.m. on October 17, 2019 with all Supervisors and the Secretary present. No visitors attended. Boots motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.

The Roadmaster report, tax collection, and permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept and advertise the proposed 2020 budget for adoption at the December 12, 2019 meeting. Motion passed all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 11-14-19 Appointment of an outside audit firm, Herrmann & Loll for the 2019 financial audit. Motion passed with all in favor.

A complaint has been received about bands playing loud music at the Mountville Storage Units on Mountville Road that is disrupting the residents in the area. Boots contacted Michelle Pekich about the complaint.

It was announced that the County Earned Income Tax Committee reappointed Berkheimer to do the Tax Collection for the county for the 2020-2024 period at % 1.7%.

Boots motioned and Zias second to upgrade the township cell phones to the Sonum at \$29.99 per phone. Motion passed with all in favor. Possibly cancel Zias and Radich phones.

Boots motioned and Zias second to reimburse Zias and Radich \$12.00 per month for using their personal cell phones. Motion passed with Zias and Boots in favor and Radich opposed.

The 2020 officers for the Lawrence County Association of Township Officials will remain the same as 2019 officers.

Boots is to check on a complaint about gravel on Barkley Road by the horse stables. The extended warranty has finally been received for the 2020 Peterbilt.

The two properties on Bauder Mill Road are continuing to remove the trash. The Frank property on North Camp Run Road is working on the new septic requirements.

The status of various road problems was discussed. Nye Road was discussed and that road closed signs are in place at the intersections.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
