

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
December 9, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, James Radish and John Zias. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall was in attendance. One visitor was present. Vice Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order. Those in attendance participated in the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor comments received was to request the placement of a new flag on the flag pole.

Radich motioned and Zias second to accept the minutes of the November 11, 2021 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster report and tax collection report were presented. Complaints have been received about the condition of Portersville Road where Columbia Gas is doing line work. Vehicles have been damaged. Boots is to contact PennDot about the situation.

Radich motioned and Boots second to pass Resolution 12-9-21-1 – the 2022 Tax Levy Resolution: General Tax: 1.79 millage; Water Tax: .29 millage; Fire Apparatus Tax: .5 millage; and Street Light Tax: 48 cents developed and 12 cents undeveloped road property frontage representing no change in taxes for 2022. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to pass Resolution 12-9-21-2 Budget Funds Appropriation for the 2022 Year. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to set the Perry Township Reorganization Meeting for Monday January 3, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. and to advertise their meeting and the Reorganizational meeting for the Perry Township Auditors. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to make the budgeted donation of \$6,000 to the Wurtemberg Perry Township VFD. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to transfer \$5,000 to the township savings account that will be transferred into the Capital Reserve Fund CD when it matures. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to accept and approve the township tax resolutions and exonerations received from the County. Motion passed.

A complaint has been received about Anthony Agostinelli dumping and burning tires at various sites in the township, one being his parent's property on Hickernell Road. The complainer who witnessed it was told to contact the county Recycling Department since they were a witness to the incident.

There was no winner for the 6 Year Auditor position so anyone interested should contact the Supervisors. It was also confirmed that Greg Fox is resigning as Solicitor for the township.

The recycling company who services the township is to be contacted about making sure they come every week for pick up to prevent overflowing onto the township parking lot.

An executive session was held following the meeting for personnel issues.  
Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
