

**PERRY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
DECEMBER 12, 2019
MINUTES**

THE TOWNSHIP MEETING for the Perry Township Board of Supervisors was held on December 12, 2019, at 4:00pm, at the Township Building. Present were John Zias, Tim Boots, James Radich, and Greg Fox, Solicitor, who also took minutes for the meeting.


The Pledge of Allegiance was done.

There were two visitors, Sam Pawloski and Trooper O'Day, from the Pennsylvania State Police.

The following motions were passed:

1. Boots motioned to accept the minutes, second by Radich, motion passed unanimously.
2. **Financial Report.** Boots motioned, Radich second, motion passed unanimously.
3. **2020 Tax Levy:** Resolution 12-12-19-1 for the 2020 tax year levy for Perry Township with the taxes set at: General Fund Tax 1.79 millage; Water Tax .29 millage; Fire Apparatus Tax .5 millage; and Light Tax at .12 cents for undeveloped property frontage and .48 cents for developed property frontage. Motion by Boots, second by Zias, motion passed unanimously.
4. **Budget Funds.** Motion to pass Resolution 12-12-19-2 budget funds appropriation for the 2020 year. Motion by Boots, second by Zias, motion passed unanimously.
5. The reorganization meeting was set for January 6, 2020, at 4:00pm, and the auditor meeting to occur immediately thereafter. Motion by Boots, second by Zias, motion passed unanimously.
6. **Capital Reserve Transfer Fund.** Motion to transfer \$5,000.00 from the Capital Reserve Fund from the General Fund Checking Account to the township savings account until the Capital Reserve Fund CD renews. Motion by Boots, second by Zias, motion passed unanimously.
7. **Perry Township Municipal Authority.** Zias motioned and Boots seconded to appoint Tom Hines to the Perry Township Municipal Authority for the five-year position beginning in January 1, 2020. Motion passed unanimously. (Tom Hines term expires December 31, 2019 – recommended for the next term). Other officers are: 12/31/23 – Ron Cowan, 12/31/22 – Jim Creese, 12/31/21 – Lynn LeViere, 12/31/20 – Brian Bush.
8. Tim Boots was sworn in as Township Supervisor for another six (6) year term.
9. Several other matters, including several properties that need to be cleaned up, were then discussed at the meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
