

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
December 13, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 13, 2018 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall, Solicitor Greg Fox and one visitor were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski-grader use

Zias motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the November 8, 2018 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented. Temporary housing was approved at 500 River Road for medical assistance with the camper in reference to be removed following the assistance not needed anymore.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 12-13-18-1 the 2019 Tax Levy which leaves the taxes the same with no increase. Motion passed with all in favor. General Fund Tax-.00179 mill; Water Tax: .00029 mill; Fire Apparatus Tax: .0005 mill; and Street Light Tax: at \$.12 for undeveloped property frontage and \$.48 for developed property frontage.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 12-13-18-2 Budget Funds Appropriation for 2019. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to set the Perry Township Reorganization meeting for January 7, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. and to contact the Auditors for their date and time and advertise both. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Zias second to make the budgeted donation of \$6,000.00 to the Wurtemberg-Perry VFD. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to transfer \$5,000 into the General Savings account for future addition to the Capital Reserve CD when it matures. Motion passed with all in favor.

The 2019 officers for the Lawrence County Association of Township Officials are Shari Baney, President; Kathy Abranovich, First Vice President; Lisa Schlemmer, Second Vice President and Janice Marshall, Secretary/Treasurer.

Boots motioned and Zias second to appoint Ron Cowan to the Perry Township Municipal Authority for the 2019 five year position. Motion passed with all in favor.

The condition of Herm's Mountville Salvage was discussed. The six trailers and structures have been removed from the John Tindall property.

To continue monitoring the Linda Angus property on Hickernell Road – no septic on property.

The Lawrence County Recycling Department is discontinuing the Blue Bins for plastics and tin cans. Only the bin for cardboard and clean papers will remain in operation. The Supervisors are to check into other options.

Roadmaster Boots discussed the progress with the McCartney Hollow Road slide and widening. The property owners signed the easement. Boots motioned and Zias second to approve the expense from Penn Power estimated at \$6,576.43 to move poles at the McCartney Hollow Road slide area. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to complete the paperwork for the road worker, Bryan Czerpak to be added to the township IRA plan the beginning of 2019. Motion passed with all in favor.

Boots motioned and Zias second to give Peggy Kimple a \$50.00 gift card in appreciation for the work she does picking up bottles and cans along the township roads. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to adjourn. Motion passed.
