RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-12-16  
REGULATION ON CAMPAIGN SIGNS ON TOWNSHIP PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Perry Township Board of Supervisors do acknowledge the placement of political campaign signs throughout the Perry Township by candidates for the elections held in the spring and fall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Perry Township Board of Supervisors do not wish to discourage such placement providing the signs are placed with permission of the landowners and follow the election guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, as elected officials for Perry Township, the Perry Township Board of Supervisors do not endorse any certain candidate for said elections and feel the placement of campaign signs on the township property could inadvertently show support for said candidates; and

**WHEREAS**, the township property is considered public property and no political advertising shall be placed or affixed to any public property.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Perry Township Board of Supervisors, Lawrence County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does hereby ban the placement of any political campaign signs on township owned property.
