

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
April 14, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 14, 2022 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Four visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order assisted by Vice-Chairman Tim Boots beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- River Road driveway that is putting water onto the roadway; Valery Kennedy-representing John Kennedy who is running for office discussed his qualifications and that because of the redistricting he will be in our district.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the March 10, 2022 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

The township set June 4th for the annual Clean-up Day from 8-12:00 and agreed that the fee for drop off to be the same- \$10.00 per regular size load and \$50.00 for large loads, with no large trucks permitted.

The county blighted structure program is now available for any structures in the township needing removed. The property at 710 Tara Drive was discussed and Marshall is to contact the county to see what the process is since the taxes are paid.

A complaint was received about Tony Agostinelli dumping tires and burning them on his parent's property on Hickernell Road. A letter is to be sent to the parents and daughter.

Boots motioned and Radich second to allocate the entire American Rescue Plan Funds received to be used as the Standard Allowance" to cover lost revenue. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Zias second to implement the \$5.00 Per Capita Tax for the Township through Act 511 and to contact Berkheimer about having them collect the current and delinquent Per Capita Township Taxes. Motion passed. Solicitor Tom Smith will handle the documentation for the tax which will be in effect in 2023.

Summer bids will be opened at the May 12 meeting.

Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise for construction of a 30'x60' metal equipment building. Motion passed.

The owners of the property on Hickernell Road are to be contacted about the amount of debris on the property and to have it cleaned up.

Boots to check on getting furnace and air conditioning system for the township building in place of the previous discussed geo-thermal system.

Following discussion of employees, Boots motioned and Radich second to eliminate the \$.50 per hour worked deduction for health insurance immediately; that the township would cover the cost of CDL schooling for employees and the mileage for the training and that the employee must sign an agreement that they will work for the township for two years after the training – if leave prior to two years, must reimburse the township for the cost. Motion passed.

Boots motioned to adjourn the meeting and Zias Second. Motion passed.
