

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
May 12, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 12, 2022 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Two visitors were present.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Sam Pawlowski- River Road driveway drainage repair is good.

Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the minutes of the April 14, 2022 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. It was reported that the auditor Herrmann and Loll has completed the 2021 Financial Audit with no findings reported but the final report hasn't been received yet.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

The summer products bids were opened. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the low bids for the summer products. Motion passed. Results were:

Aggregates: McClymonds Supply & Transit: 800 tons #8-\$23.76/ton; 600 tons #57-\$21.26; 400 tons R-3 Rip Rap-\$20.53; 100 tons R-4 Rip Rap-\$20.53; 100 tons R-5 Rip Rap-\$30.03.

Emulsions: Russell Standard-50 tons Premium Cold Patch-\$87.50; Russell Standard-10,000 gallons FOB CRS-2 Emulsion-\$2.35; Suit-Kote-30,000 gallons delivered CRS-2 Emulsion-\$2.58.

Fuels – Reed Oil-LS-6000 gallons on-road Diesel-\$ 4.8774; and 2000 gallons heating oil-\$4.4866.

Culvert Pipe-Culvert's Inc. – 36" N-12 smooth bore plastic pipe delivered - \$53.25 with a two piece minimum for delivery

Boots motioned and "Radich second to rescind the August 12, 2021 motion to purchase a trailer not to exceed \$15,000. Motion passed with all in favor.

Radich motioned and Boots second to purchase a B-B trailer from Leonard Truck and Trailer for \$21,768.59 with it being the only trailer with the specifications requested in the telephone bids. Motion passed with all in favor.

The annual Clean-up Day is June 4<sup>th</sup> from 8-12:00 and agreed that the fee for drop off to be the same- \$10.00 per regular size load and \$50.00 for large loads, with no large trucks permitted.

The county blighted structure program is now available for any structures in the township needing removed. The property at 710 Tara Drive was discussed and the county confirmed that the taxes are paid. The matter is tabled.

A complaint was received about Tony Agostinelli dumping tires and burning them on his parent's property on Hickernell Road. A letter was sent to the parents and daughter.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass and submit the county liquid fuels resolution #5-12-22 to the Lawrence County Commissioners requesting \$11,212.87 in a grant for work to be done to River Road. Motion passed with all in favor.

Advertisement was tabled for construction of a 30'x60' metal equipment building until the specifications are decided.

Boots motioned and Radich second to pass Resolution 5-12-22-2 to Levy and assess a Per Capita Tax, establish discounts and penalties and provide for the collection of the tax and delinquent payments and prescribing fees and costs for delinquent payments. Motion passed with all in favor. Copies of the Resolution are to be sent to the Solicitor, the school and Berkheimer.

Two letters were sent to the Linda Angus and Amber Miller for the property on Hickernell Road about the amount of debris on the property and to get it cleaned up.

The water run off problem at Route 488 and Mercer Road was discussed and noted that a meeting is set with PennDot Representatives to try to get the problem resolved. PennDot had agreed in 2018 to take care of the problem in exchange for the 2017 winter maintenance that the township did on Pleasant Hill Road while the state replaced a bridge.

It was noted that notification has been received that PAWC is raising their rates.

Discussion was tabled for the construction of a 30' x 60' equipment building.

No action was taken on advertising for a new employee.

Getting furnace and air conditioning system for the township building office area and fire department garage area was tabled.

The Guardian Insurance policy change was tabled until closer to renewal time.

The Township Office and Tax Collection Office will be closed the week of June 13<sup>th</sup>.

Boots motioned and Radich second to hire James Syphrit as a full time laborer with a CDL license at \$18.00/hour to follow the Full Time Job Description, MVR check and probationary period. Motion passed.

Boots motioned and Radich second to hire Cadon Sherwood-Bauder as a part time laborer at \$13.75/hour to follow the Part Time Job Description, MVR check and probationary period. Motion passed.

The Supervisors agreed to discuss the pay scale for the township employees at the June meeting.

Boots motioned to adjourn the meeting and Radich Second. Motion passed.
