

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
August 11, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 11, 2022 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, James Radich and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Janice Marshall was absent; and Solicitor Thomas Smith was present. Four visitors were present. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the meeting agenda. Motion passed.

Vice-Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Fred Schuster – Condition of 710 Tara Drive house being beyond repair; Sam Pawlowski-chipper and spreader purchase.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the July 14, 2022 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Boots motioned and Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

Boots motioned and Zias second to pass Resolution 8-11-22 providing for the Agility Partner Agreement with PennDot to be signed the Agility Agreement. Motion passed.

Marshall contacted PennDot for confirmation that the small bridge on River Road is a state owned bridge and not a township bridge, it was confirmed.

Boots contacted PennDot about the possibility of receiving fine millings when available.

A request was received for the placement of a blind person sign for Hickernell Road.

Tabled: Discussion was tabled for the Boots motioned and Radich second to advertise for the construction of a 30' x 60' equipment building once the specifications and location are decided. Motion passed.

Tabled: Getting furnace and air conditioning system for the township building office area and fire department garage area was tabled – Boots to get information.

Tabled: The Guardian Insurance policy change was tabled until closer to renewal time.

The problem with 705 Tara Drive not mowing their grass was discussed, a certified letter was sent but not signed for. A letter is to be placed on the owner's door and a photo taken.

Marshall will draft the letter for the September meeting for Supervisors and Solicitor to approve.

Boots motioned to adjourn the meeting and Zias Second. Motion passed.
