

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
February 9, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 19, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Five visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order assisted by Vice-Chairman Tim Boots beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Fredrick Shuster and Jeff Markle talked about update on demolition on 710 Tara Drive; submission to County Land Development Committee for start of demolition.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the January 3, 2023 meeting agenda with the addition for approval and appointment of the ECMS Municipal Engineer to be Frank B. Taylor Engineering as the Municipal Engineer. Motion passed with all in favor. Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. An executive session was held after meeting to discuss personnel issue.

A report was received from the township auditors – Supervisor compensation was set at \$18.00/hour for Roadmaster and working Supervisor was set at \$19.00/hour and the reimbursement for mileage is set at the federal rate of \$.65.5 per mile.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

Discussion of a 30' x 60' equipment building, will need to be advertised. Supervisors looking into getting bid package ready.

Discussion about possibly getting prices to fix/redo the Perry Township sign on Rte. 488.

Discussion about options with replacing township building floor.

Information discussed about estimate for repairs on 2020 Peterbilt Truck with Warranty coverage.

Discussion on the draft of A Tall Grass and Weed Ordinance. Solicitor gave the draft to the supervisors a copy to take a look over. Draft of ordinance will be look over and discuss again at March meeting.

Workers Comp Claim discussed for Firefighter injured at fire call. Firefighter is doing ok now after 2 ER visits.

Notification received from the County Planning Department concerning: Levis Road Subdivision.

Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Boots Second. Motion passed.
