

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 9, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 9, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Three visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order assisted by supervisor James Radich. Visitor's comments: Fred Schuster wanted to thank everyone for their help in getting the process done for the demolition of his property at 710 Tara Drive. Jonathon Magee mentioned concerns about the road maintenance on Magee Road and Breakneck Bridge Road.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 9, 2023 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

There was discussion about a possible ordinance for tall grass and weeds. Advertisement of draft of the ordinance is to go forward with adoption of the ordinance # 4-13-23 Tall Grass and Weed at the April 13, 2023 meeting. Boots motioned, Zias second. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day will be held at the Perry Township Municipal Building on March 23 from 10:00-12:00 for the payment of 2023 Lawrence County Taxes.

The Supervisors discussed the Demolition of 710 Tara Drive and the Submission to Lawrence County Redevelopment for Blight Grant Program. Demolition complete, Township paid for demolition. Submission to County for reimbursement once check clears bank.

The township will set a date for the annual Clean-up Day. Date to be announced.

Discussion for Summer Bidding opening for road work materials. Advertisement will be in Ledger on April 21, 2023, and April 28, 2023 to accept and open bidding at April 13, 2023 meeting.

Discussion to donate money to the first responders in Ellwood City VFD and WPVFD to offset cost of expense for first responders. The departments work together at emergency calls. Money to be taken out of American Rescue Fund for both fire departments. Radich motioned and Zias second. Motion passed with all in favor.

Discussion about upcoming Roadwork Construction on State Route 488 over Interstate 79 will begin March 20, 2023-Fall of 2023.

The Supervisors discussed the repairs to 2011 Ford F-550.

Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Boots second. Motion passed.
