

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
June 8, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Four visitors were present. Sam Pawlowski, Gerard Walzer, Fredrick Schuster, and Jeffery Markle.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Gerard Walzer stated he was happy to see American flag back up at township building. Fredrick Schuster and Jeffery Markle both discussed their concerns with garbage and tall grass and weeds for properties in the township; 705 Tara Drive, 407 Meadowland Ave and 224 Reno Road.

Radich motioned and Zias second to accept the minutes of the May 8, 2023 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Radich motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. Scott DiFrischia-Dewits Junkyard renewal Permit, William Christie-Non UCC Building Permit-Garage not attached, Kyle Wright-Non UCC Building Permit- Pole Building, and Shawn Meskell-Trailer Removal Permit.

Municipal Authority request was made to obtain permission for internet and possibly phone services when the township renews with Armstrong. Armstrong has since made some changes in their contracts renewals. More information will be needed before a decision can be made.

Several complaints have been made about garbage and debris and tall grass and weeds with several properties. Supervisors; Zias and James Radich, and Solicitor; Smith discussed the concerns and gave clarification on both ordinances violations. Four courtesy letters were mailed out as a reminder for clean-up and cutting of the grass and weeds. Properties who received letters were: 705 Tara Drive, 224 Reno Road, 552 Heinz Camp Road, and 407 Meadowland Ave. Nuisance Ordinance 11-8-12 and Tall Grass and Weeds Ordinance 4-13-23 can be found on township website or a copy can be requested at township building.

Discussion about updated plans for building garage behind township building were discussed. It was decided that more information would be needed. Plans to discuss about updated plans will be continued at next monthly township meeting.

SAM.gov entity registration for use of any grants and emergency funding. Renewal of township entity for the upcoming year was completed.

WPVFD Fire Tax Credit has been completed. Fire Tax Credit reimbursement checks mailed out to volunteer fire department members.

Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Radich Second. Motion passed.
