

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
July 13, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 13, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: Tim Boots, and James Radich. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Seven visitors were present. Sam Pawlowski, Gerard Walzer, Fredrick Schuster, Jeffery Markle, Jonathon Magee, Barbara Magee and Joshua Ottaviani.

Vice Chairman Tim Boots called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Gerard Walzer congratulated road crew on job well done. Fredrick Schuster and Jeffery Markle both discussed their concerns with progress of garbage and tall grass and weeds for properties in the township; 705 Tara Drive, 407 Meadowland Ave and 224 Reno Road. Joshua Ottaviani; Perry Township EMA gave some feedback from a safety training seminar he attended.

Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the June 8, 2023 meeting. Motion passed with both in favor. Radich motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with both in favor.

The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented. John and Herman Stafford-Mountville Salvage renewal Junkyard Permit, Jonathon Chad Moffett- Tindall Junkyard renewal Junkyard Permit, UCC Building Permit-Brandon Cushta-Ground Mount Solar Panels.

Several complaints have been made about garbage and debris and tall grass and weeds with several properties. Supervisors; James Radich and Tim Boots, and Solicitor; Smith discussed the concerns and gave clarification on both ordinances violations potential steps forward to correct the violations.

Radich motioned and Boots second to move forward with the next steps being a citation of violations to be filed with the Lawrence County District Magistrate office. Motion passed with both in favor. (Tall Grass and Weeds Ordinance 4-13-23 can be found on township website or a copy can be requested at township building.)

Discussion about updated plans for the building of a pole building behind township building were continued. Preliminary bids determined that the cost would be over \$22,500. State bidding requirements state that the bidding of advertisements would need to be advertised in public newspaper before making a decision on the building steps forward.

WPVFD applied for a state grant for \$25,000-\$100,000- Approval is still pending.

Tax Collector-Janice Marshall will be accepting 2023 Perry Township and Ellwood City School District taxes in person. The hours for July and August 2023 will be Mondays and Tuesdays 8AM-1PM at township building and other times by appointment only.

Boots motioned to adjourn the meeting and Radich Second. Motion passed.
