

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
August 10, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 10, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias and Timothy Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Four visitors were present. Sam Pawlowski, Gerard Walzer, Fredrick Schuster, and Jeffery Markle.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Gerard Walzer commented on road work done on Shingle Hollow Road. Fredrick Schuster and Jeffery Markle both discussed their concerns with conditions and progress of tall grass and weeds for both properties in the township; 705 Tara Drive, and 224 Reno Road.

John Zias motioned and Tim Boots second to accept the minutes of the July 13, 2023 meeting. Motion passed with both in favor. John Zias motioned and Tim Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with both in favor.

The Roadmaster report was presented and Permit reports were no permits to report this month.

Several complaints have been made about the conditions of the tall grass and weeds with two properties: 705 Tara Drive, and 224 Reno Road. Supervisors; John Zias and Tim Boots, and Solicitor; Smith discussed the concerns and gave clarification on the ordinances violations steps made forward to correct the violations. The township filed citations on August 2, 2023 with Lawrence County Magistrates Office on those property violations. (Tall Grass and Weeds Ordinance 4-13-23 can be found on township website or a copy can be requested at township building.)

Complaints were made about the weeds on the edge of Van Gorder Mill Road and Route 488. Township workers cleaned up weeds and mowed the grass.

John Zias motioned and Tim Boots second to ratify for advertisement for sealed bids on construction of pole building to be built behind township building. Advertisements to be made public in Ellwood City Ledger. Motion passed with both in favor.

Lawrence County Commissioners awarded Perry Township for the Liquid Fuels grant requested for purchase of a 2023 Ford F-550 truck in amount of \$30,000.

WPVFD applied for a state grant for \$25,000-\$100,000- Approval is still pending.

Township Office will be closed on Wednesday August 21st and Thursday August 22nd 2023. Questions and concerns can be directed by phone to the board of supervisors on those days of closure.

John Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Tim Boots second. Motion passed.
