

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
September 14, 2023 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 14, 2023 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, James Radich and Tim Boots. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni; and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. 9 visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Fred Schuster and Jeffrey Markle commented on future steps to correct the tall grass and weeds with the properties in violation of ordinance 4-13-23. The solicitor discussed the steps he had taken to get the citations filed at the Lawrence County Magistrate's office. Lynn LeViere commented on possibility of obtaining internet services for Municipal Authority pump house site with Armstrong in upcoming franchise agreement renewal, Barbara Magee commented on ancestry and changes of township roads from years past. John Henstock commented on some changes in family ancestry in the township past. Janice Marshall commented on some township mapping changes and where to find more information.

John Zias motioned and James Radich second to accept the minutes of the August 10, 2023 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. John Zias motioned and James Radich second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Financial report was present. The Roadmaster and Permit reports were presented.

The complaints for properties in violation of Tall Weeds and Grass Ordinance 4-13-23 properties: 705 Tara Drive and 224 Reno Road were discussed. The solicitor Thomas Smith discussed the steps he had taken to get the citations filed at the Lawrence County Magistrate's office and awaiting a date for hearing from the Magistrate's Office

John Zias motioned and Tim Boots second to open bidding and award the lowest bid for steel pole building. The awarded bid went to Carter Lumber for \$50,500.00 for construction material and labor. The bids not awarded were Timbertime Pole Barns for \$52,000.00 for construction material and labor and 84 Lumber for \$32,645.09 for construction material only. Motion passed all in favor.

WPVFD applied for a State Grant for \$25,000-\$100,000 which was denied by the state at this time.

Tax Collector Janice Marshall collected township taxes in July and August 2023. July taxes were \$46,990.74 and August taxes were \$120,092.14 July and August total township taxes combined were \$167,082.88.

John Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Tim Boots Second. Motion passed.
