

Perry Township Board of Supervisors  
February 8, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 8, 2024 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Tyler Hill. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Four visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order assisted by Vice-Chairman Tim Boots beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: James Radich commented on garage doors-update on pole building. Jeffrey Markle-Commented on 705 Tara Drive.

Zias motioned and Hill second to accept the minutes of the January 2, 2024 meeting agenda. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Hill second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Financial, and Permit reports were presented. Dustin Kramer-Building Permit for Pole Building on Studebaker Road.

A report was received from the township auditors – Supervisor compensation was set at \$18.00/hour for Roadmaster and working Supervisor was set at \$21.00/hour and the reimbursement for mileage is set at the federal rate of \$.67 per mile.

Herrmann & Loll CPA is currently in the process of completing 2023 financial reports for the township and the tax collector.

Boots motioned and Zias second to ratify the opening of a public funds escrow CD at WesBanco in name of Estate of Phyllis Jean LeViere Tax ID # 27-037400 in the amount of \$2,000 following the sewage agreement. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to ratify to provide WPVFD \$120,040.00 to be taken out of the Fire Apparatus Fund account for the purchase of a chassis for the new tanker truck upon request of invoice before payment. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Hill second to approve the appointment of the ECMS Municipal Engineer to be Frank B. Taylor Engineering as the Municipal Engineer. Motion passed with all in favor.

The Lawrence County Tax Outreach Day will be held at the Perry Township Municipal Building on Tuesday March 26, 2024 from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM for the payment of the 2024 Lawrence County Taxes.

The township supervisors will look into setting up a day for 2024 Clean-Up day in the township and to try to keep the costs the same as last year. \$10.00 per regular size load and \$50.00 for large loads, with no large trucks to be permitted.

The Co-Star Salt contract has been submitted for the 2024-2024 year-60 tons.

Zias motioned and Hill second to approve the appointment of the ECMS Municipal Engineer to be Frank B. Taylor Engineering as the Municipal Engineer. Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to switch phone services at the township building office from the current carrier Bright Speed to Armstrong after discussion and proposal provided.

Armstrong Cable Franchise Renewal Agreement with Cohen Law Group representing the township still remains in negotiations steps. Cohen Law Group awaiting Armstrong's response

Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Hill Second. Motion passed with all in favor.
