

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
March 14, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 14, 2024 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots and Tyler Hill. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Four visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order assisted by supervisor Tyler Hill. Visitor's comments: Barbara Magee inquired about clean-up day and Deborah Bollinger mentioned concern about trees across road from her house.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the minutes of the February 8, 2024 meeting.
Motion passed with all in favor.

Zias motioned and Boots second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills.
Motion passed with all in favor.

The Roadmaster, Tax Collection and Permit reports were presented.

Zias motioned and Hill second to ratify and accept a bid for garage door opener for the new pole building. Motioned passed with all in favor.

Discussion for Summer Bidding opening for road work materials. Advertisement will be in the New Castle News on March 20, 2024 and March 27, 2024 to accept and open bidding at April 11, 2024 meeting.

The township supervisors set the date for the annual Clean-up Day on June 8, 2024 from 8AM-12PM at both WPVFD and Township building locations. Fees for drop off to be same as year before. \$10.00 per regular size load and \$50.00 for large loads, with no large trucks permitted.

Discussion about EMA Coordinator –Joshua Ottaviani having completed his state certification requirements through Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA). The required certification is valid for 5 years.

Township Office will be closed the week of April 15th-18th 2024.

The secretary will be attending the PSATS State Educational Session in Hershey, PA. Any business, questions or concerns please reach out to a member of the Board of Supervisors.

Armstrong Cable Franchise Renewal Agreement with Cohen Law Group representing the township still remains in negotiations steps. Cohen Law Group awaiting Armstrong's response.

Zias motioned and Hill seconded to add 3 items-other business to the agenda. Motion passed with all in favor. Additions to the agenda were as follow: to advertise in the New Castle News and accept sealed bids at the next township meeting for the sale of 2005 International Dump Truck; as is, concrete work to be done to inside of existing 30x70 foot pole building, and construction and materials to build a 50x50 foot pole building. Payment for the pole building construction and concrete work to be paid out of American Rescue Fund. Advertisements for all sealed bids will be in the New Castle News on March 22, 2024 and March 29, 2024 to accept and open bidding at April 11, 2024 meeting.

Zias motioned to adjourn the meeting and Hill second. Motion passed.
