

Perry Township Board of Supervisors
April 11, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes

The Perry Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 11, 2024 at the Perry Township Municipal Building. Supervisors in attendance were: John Zias, Tim Boots, and Tyler Hill. Secretary/Treasurer Brandie Massioni and Solicitor Thomas Smith were present. Six visitors were present.

Chairman John Zias called the meeting to order beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor's comments: Deborah Bollinger discussed concerns about the trees across road from her house. Solicitor gave his recommendations.

Zias motioned and Hill second to accept the minutes of the March 14, 2024 meeting. Motion passed with all in favor. Hill motioned and Zias second to accept the treasurer's report and pay the bills. Motion passed with all in favor. It was reported that the auditor Herrmann and Loll has completed the 2023 Financial Audit with no findings reported. The 2023 Financial Audit Report was advertised in New Castle News on Thursday April 11, 2024 and a copy was filed at the Lawrence County Courthouse.

The Roadmaster, and financial reports were present. There were no permits to report.

The summer products bids were opened. Hill motioned and Zias second to accept the low bids for the summer products. Motion passed. Results were:

Aggregates: McClymonds Supply & Transit: 800 tons #8-\$29.40/ton; 300 tons #57-\$24.40; 300 tons R-3 Rip Rap-\$24.40; 100 tons R-4 Rip Rap-\$24.40; 100 tons R-5 Rip Rap-\$37.90.

Emulsions: Russell Standard-50 tons Premium Cold Patch-\$105.50; Russell Standard-30,000 gallons FOB CRS-2 Emulsion-\$2.73; 20,000 gallons delivered CRS-2 Emulsion-\$2.15.

Fuels – Reed Oil-LS-6000 gallons on-road Diesel-\$ 2.80; and 2000 gallons heating oil-\$2.91.

Sealed bids for material and construction of a 50x50ft Steel Pole Building were opened. Hill motioned and Zias second to accept the low bids for the material and construction of the pole building. Motion passed. Results: WPA Builder's for \$52,600.00

Sealed bids for concrete work on the 30x70 existing pole building floor were opened. Hill motioned and Boots second to accept the low bids for the concrete work. Motion passed. Results were: Z'Crete for \$7,125.00

Sealed bids for sale of 2005 International Truck were opened. Hill motioned and Zias second to accept or reject the highest bids for the sale of the 2005 International Truck. Motion passed. Results were: Chase Auto Salvage for \$850.00

It was discussed to look into possible purchase of a used leaf blower from Stephenson Equipment. Supervisors agreed to continue to look into more options for a possible purchase of a leaf blower.

Armstrong Cable Franchise Renewal Agreement with Cohen Law Group representing the township still remains in negotiations steps. Cohen Law Group awaiting Armstrong's response.

Zias motioned and Hill second to add an addition to the meeting agenda. Addition was to make Supervisor Tim Boots to be the authorized signer on the purchase of 2023 F-550 and to look into financial options for the purchase of the truck to be discussed at the next meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.

Hill motioned to adjourn the meeting and Boots Second. Motion passed.
